POSITIONING ORDER OF START NUMBERS AND ADVERTISING TEXTS

Appendix No. 3



1 – Two start numbers for each rear side window. Digit height is 20 cm and digit line thickness can't be less than 25 mm. Digits must be in fluorescent orange colour (PMS 804) and may be light reflecting. Numbers must be stuck alongside drivers' names.

2 – First letters of the names followed by surnames of 1st and 2nd drivers' as well as national country flags of ASN's, which issued the licences, must be stuck on both rear side windows alongside the start numbers. Names must conform to the following:

- To be in white "Helvetica" font;
- First letter of the name and the surname must be written in uppercase;
- The Uppercase letters must be 6 cm in height and 1 cm in line thickness.
- Surname of the 1st driver is written higher on both sides of the car.

3 – Two rectangular "Organiser's Advertisement" stickers must be stuck on both of the front doors. Each sticker must be stuck horizontally next to frontal side of the door (top of the sticker must be 7 – 10 cm lower than the lower edge of the window). Sticker width is 67 cm, sticker height: 17 cm. No other marking is allowed less than 10 cm from this sticker, except car colours.

4 – Rally logo. Must not be larger than 43 x 21.5 cm and must be stuck on the front bonnet on the car.

5 – Issued by the Organiser. LASF advertisement, stuck on top of the front windshield (not wider than 10 cm from the upper edge of the windshield, visible from inside the car).
